Since 1963, our community has invested and supported a Boys & Girls Club that has transformed the lives of tens of thousands of young people. We've grown continually over the last several years, expanded into school buildings, strengthened our programs and services, and found ways to meet essential needs for young people from providing healthy meals to clothing and school supplies.

But together, we can do even more for our kids.

THE NEED

In 1965, Boys & Girls Club of Las Cruces made the long-term move to what many know as the old Presbyterian Church on Las Cruces Avenue. Since then, this facility has been a home away from home to tens of thousands of youth. Although the facility has never compromised our ability to deliver our mission, at just over 6,800 square feet, it continues to limit the amount of youth we can provide consistent daily services to. The increased need for our services becomes more apparent by long waiting lists of youth each year, who we are unable to serve due to our building size. Moreover, a building of this age undoubtedly brings on multiple challenges including frequent costly repairs and the lack of infrastructure needed to provide the technology and tools that are imperative for young people to achieve 21st Century success.



THE DREAM

For years, we have dreamed of the day that we can welcome Las Cruces kids and teens to a brand new, state-of-the art facility. This new facility will allow us to triple the amount of youth we are able to serve, fulfilling the same mission we have always worked for - building great futures for young people, but in bigger, more meaningful ways.

THE PLAN

- •The new facility will be located on the El Paseo Corridor, near a new housing project, with plans for other community projects nearby
- •The facility will be nearly 30,000 square feet, and include a full size gymnasium, a state of the art STEM Lab, a separate wing for teens, and much more.
- •The new building will give BGCLC the capacity to serve around 300 kids per day.
- •BGCLC will also work with the City of Las Cruces Parks and Recreation Department and other community entities to allow after-hours usage of the gymnasium and other Club amenities.




